

Information notice pursuant to Art. 13 of EU Regulation No. 2016/679

Dear Sir/Madam,

we would like to inform you that EU Regulation No. 679/2016 "General Data Protection Regulation" provides for the protection of individuals with regard to the processing of personal data. According to the aforementioned regulation, such processing shall be carried out in accordance with the principles of lawfulness, fairness and transparency, adequacy, relevance and limitation, accuracy and updating, non-excessiveness and accountability. Personal data are processed, pursuant to Art. 6 paragraph 1 letter a) of the GDPR, subject to your consent.

Therefore, we provide you with the following information:

1. The personal data you provide will be processed exclusively to allow you to participate in the Call for Applications for admission to the Foundation Course for the academic year 2026/2027.
2. The processing of personal data will be carried out by automated and/or manual means. The determination of the data retention period complies with the principle of necessity of processing. The personal data you provide will therefore be stored for the entire period necessary to achieve the purposes for which they were provided, in accordance with the applicable legislation.
3. Your participation in the Call for Applications for admission to the Foundation Course for the academic year 2026/2027 is free and voluntary and the provision of your data for this purpose is mandatory. Any refusal to provide your data will result in the impossibility of taking part in the Call for Applications for admission to the Foundation Course for the academic year 2026/2027.
4. You may decide to withdraw your consent until the moment your data are transferred, without affecting the lawfulness of the processing based on the explicit consent given prior to the withdrawal.
5. The independent Data Controller is the University of Pisa, with registered office in Pisa (Italy), Lungarno Pacinotti 43, represented by the Rector pro tempore, who may be contacted at the following PEC address: protocollo@pec.unipi.it.
6. The University of Pisa has appointed a Data Protection Officer pursuant to Art. 37 of EU Regulation No. 679/2016. The Data Protection Officer may be contacted at the following addresses:
